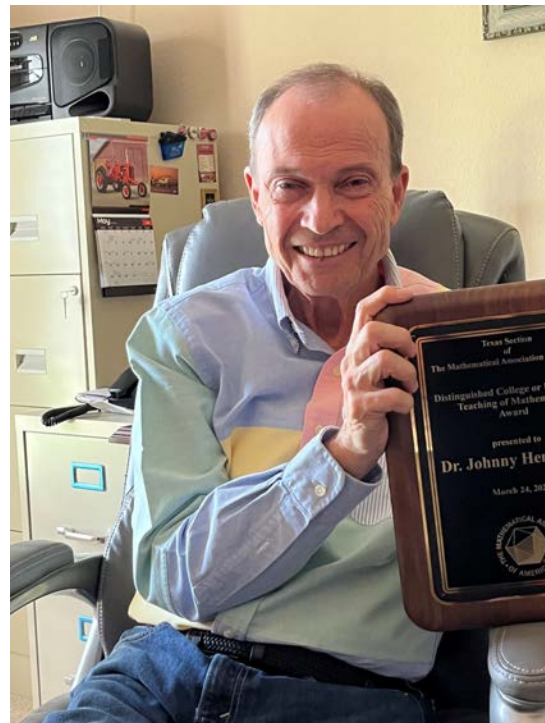

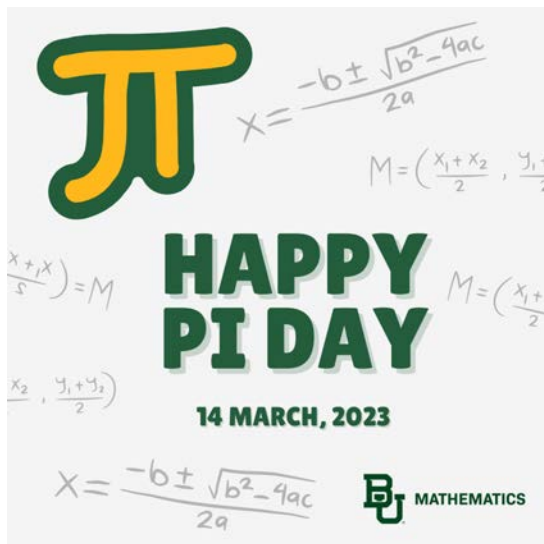


Mobius Club Attends Mathematical Conference

Mobius Mathematics Society Hosted an Exciting Pi Day Event

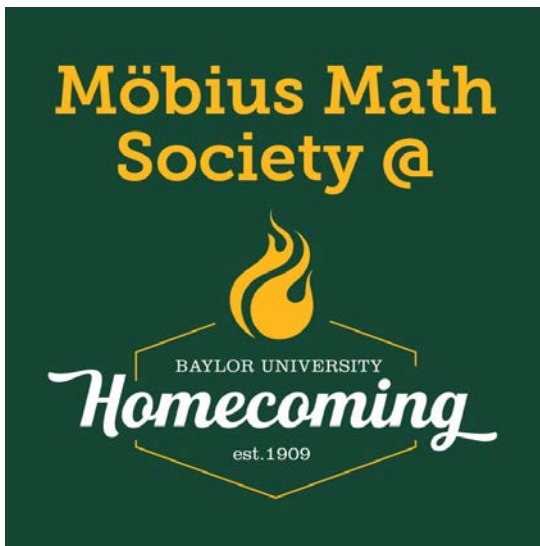
This past Tuesday, Baylor's Mobius Mathematics Society hosted an exciting Pi Day event, celebrating the mathematical constant π and its importance in our lives.

Dr. Jennifer Loe, presents a talk entitled "A Mathematician's Work at Sandia National Laboratories."



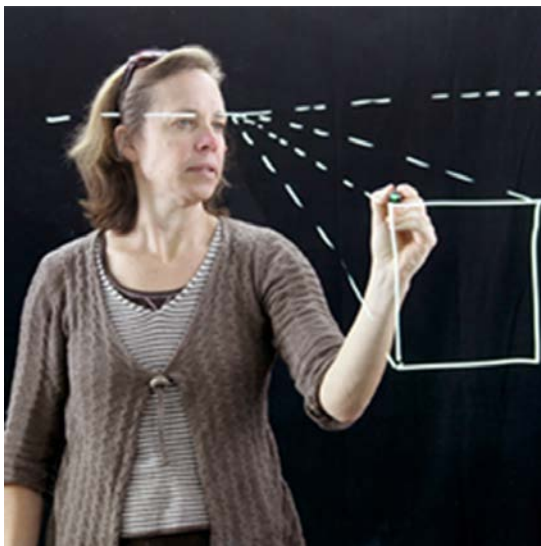
Mobius Math Society at Baylor Homecoming
